From the page VisTrails Overview, "VisTrails was designed to manage rapidly evolving scientific workflows and provenance that support simulations, data exploration and visualization." Jeff is currently the director of the DOI North Central Climate Science Center where he manages and conducts research on how natural and cultural land management can respect the non-stationary nature of climate. A current research theme is how dynamic species distribution models can contribute to vulnerability assessment and adaptation planning.
